The Roanoke Valley Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (the "RVSPCA") is very fortunate to have many committed volunteers, without whom we would not be able to fulfill our mission to create a community where there are no homeless cats or dogs through the power of adoption, prevention and intervention. We look forward to your help.

The RVSPCA values and understands the importance of families giving back through volunteering. Due to the unknown vaccination history of many shelter animals, volunteers under 16 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or another trusted adult volunteer. Children volunteering with an adult be at least 10 years of age.

Steps to Becoming a Family Volunteer for the RVSPCA:

1. Complete and return your Family Volunteer Application to the RVSPCA Programs Coordinator.
2. Pay a one-time, non-refundable \$30 volunteer registration fee. This covers the cost of up to 3 volunteer t-shirts, materials and insurance. This fee helps to ensure that the vast majority of our funding is spent directly on animal care. Please understand that your volunteer fee is non-refundable and will be considered a contribution to the shelter should you decide to forgo volunteering. T-shirts awarded upon completion of orientation and 4 hours of volunteer work.
3. Once your application and fee are received, you will receive an invitation to register for Volunteer Orientation. Volunteer orientation is held in-person monthly on a Saturday at 9:00AM. Online orientation is also available. Contact edams@rvspca.org for more information on Volunteer Orientation.
4. Attend additional online or in-person training as required for specific activities.
5. Commit to 4 hours a month to remain an Active volunteer.

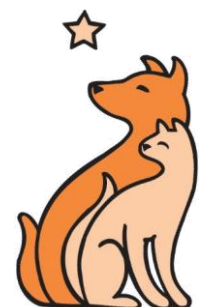

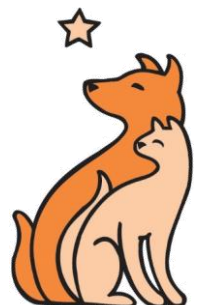

## ZOONOTIC DISEASE DISCLOSURE

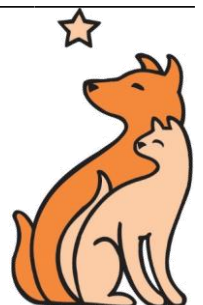
Zoonotic diseases are those that can be passed from other species to humans. Examples are ringworm, tapeworm, roundworms and rabies. We impress upon all volunteers that safe handling techniques and hygiene are important elements of protecting ourselves from these diseases. Washing hands after handling any animal is critical. Please understand that many of the animals arriving at the shelter have had no previous veterinary care and may expose you to disease. While the occurrence of disease transmission is rare, please understand that the Roanoke Valley SPCA cannot assume financial, medical, or veterinary responsibility for any transmissions that may occur to yourself, your family or companion animals.

Anyone who is pregnant or may become pregnant or has a compromised immune system should consult their physician before volunteering with the Roanoke Valley SPCA.

I understand that because I may handle animals, it is important for me to speak with my physician about the tetanus and rabies pre-exposure vaccinations. On behalf of myself, my heirs, personal representatives, and executors, I release, discharge, indemnify, and hold harmless the RVSPCA, its agents, servants, and employees for any and all claims, causes of action, or demands, of any nature or cause, including costs and attorney's fees incurred by the RVSPCA in connection with the same, based on damages or injuries which may be incurred, or sustained by me in any way connected with my services for the RVSPCA, including, but not limited to: animal bites, accidents, or injuries.
