The Roanoke Valley SPCA Best in Show returns for its seventeenth year. Artists and pet lovers are invited to create artwork in any medium for the competition. The images can be of pets or animal friends.

The artwork will be exhibited Thursday, April 25th with a VIP reception and preview prior to the show opening. Images of the artwork will be shown at Best in Show and on the website. Unsold artwork will remain for sale online until the end of May.

ELIGIBILITY

Now in its seventeenth year, Best in Show 2024 is open to artists and animal lovers of all ages and levels of experience.

HOW TO ENTER

- Entry fee is \$30 for each canvas for adult participants age 18 and over.
- Entry fee is \$25 for each canvas for student artists under age 18.
- Multiple submissions are invited and discounts are available for artists entering multiple pieces. See website for details.
- Entry fee is \$25 for each sculpture.

CANVAS ENTRIES

- Use only 12" square *canvases*, available at the Roanoke Valley SPCA and the Left of Center Art Space. Canvases may be picked up during regular business hours. Addresses and hours at bottom of next page. Art not on designated canvases will not be accepted.
- Subject matter appropriate to SPCA: pets, animal friends of all kinds. Dogs and cats may comprise the majority of entries, but past works have included goldfish, horses, pigs, flying squirrels, parrots, llamas and salamanders.
- All 2-dimensional media (painting, drawing, collage, photography, mixed media, etc.) is acceptable.
- Do not build up canvas surfaces or add dimensional elements beyond bas-relief unless you use very sturdy materials. Do not exceed the 12" square footprint. ***All paintings must be completely dry.***
- ***Do not add any additional framing to the outside of the canvas.***
- Do not add hanging wire to the back of the canvas.
- Please enter only work that has not been in Best in Show before.
- Continuing the artwork on the sides of the canvas increases sales potential.

SCULPTURE ENTRIES

- Subject matter can be an image of any pets or animal friends. The sculpture category includes dog and cat houses, pet beds, pet food stations, etc. These can be full size and suitable for pet housing, or presented as sculptural prototypes. If full size, please use pet-safe materials.
- All 3-D media are acceptable (papier maché, cloth, wood, metal, wire, plaster, foam-core or mixed).
- Please provide a pedestal with protective felt or bumpers on the bottom edges.

IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER

- Blank canvases may be picked up at Roanoke Valley SPCA and the Left of Center Art Space during regular business hours until February 28, 2024. Addresses and hours are below.
- DELIVERY OF COMPLETED ARTWORK must be made between Friday, March 15 and Saturday, March 30, 2024 at the Roanoke Valley SPCA, Monday - Saturday, Noon - 7:00 p.m.
- **2024 VIP Reception & Preview: Thursday, April 25, 5:00 - 6:00 p.m.** and **2024 Show & Sale: Thursday, April 25, 6:00 - 9:00 p.m.** at Charter Hall in The Market Building, 32 Market Square, SE, Roanoke.
- Purchases of art can be made at the opening reception, during the show, or online through **the end of May 2024.**
- At the conclusion of the online exhibit, artists may pick up unsold artwork at the **Roanoke Valley SPCA** during normal business hours (Noon - 7:00 p.m.) Monday - Saturday. Any artwork not claimed by close of business May 4, 2024 becomes property of the Roanoke Valley SPCA.

AWARDS

The Best in Show winner will be chosen by the guest art judges and will be featured in the 2024 Roanoke Valley SPCA Annual Report and any promotional materials for 2025 Best in Show. Additional awards will be selected by other event sponsors. A full listing of award categories can be found on the website.

SALES

- **All entries must be for sale. No pre-sales. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- A 50% commission will be taken from all sales and donated to the Roanoke Valley SPCA. 100% donation is very appreciated.
- Please price your work fairly, in the spirit of a non-profit fundraiser. All entries must be priced at a minimum of \$30 (including student paintings). We reserve the right to revise pricing if warranted. The artist will be contacted should the need arise.
- Unsold art will be held at the Roanoke Valley SPCA and offered for sale through the Best in Show website through the end of May. Sales [online](#) expand the opportunities for the artists' work to be seen more extensively and make it easy for buyers to view and purchase available paintings.
